12 **SPIRIT ANOINTED?**

- What does it mean that the Spirit "Anointed" Him?
- We sometimes use the word incorrectly.
- Anointing is a one time experience.
- What we are speaking us should be called "Presence" or "Power."
- In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when you are gathered together, along with my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ I Cor 5:4 NKJV

13 **ANOINTED, MASHACH, STRONG'S #4886:**

- To anoint, to rub with oil, especially in order to consecrate someone or something. Appearing almost 70 times, *mashach* refers to the custom of rubbing or smearing with sacred oil to consecrate holy persons or holy things. Priests (Lev.8:12; 16:32) and Kings (2 Sam. 2:4; 5:3; I Kings 1:39) in particular were installed in their offices by anointing. In Ex 40:9-14, the Tabernacle was to be anointed, as well as the Alter, the Laver, and the High Priest's sons. The most important derivation of *masach* is *mashiyach* (Messiah), "the anointed one." As Jesus was and is the promised ANOINTED ONE, His title came to be "Jesus the Messiah." Messiah was translated into Greek as *Christos*, thus His designation, "Jesus Christ."
