2  **EXODUS 20:1-17**

3  **EXODUS 20:1-17 NKJV**

- And God spoke all these words, saying:
- 2" I *am* the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.
- 3" You shall have no other gods before Me.
- 4" You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of *anything* that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; 5 you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the LORD your God, *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth *generations* of those who hate Me, 6 but showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.
- "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold *him* guiltless who takes His name in vain.

4  **EXODUS 20:1-17**

- "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you.

- 16" You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 17" You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his male servant, nor his female servant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that is your neighbor's."

5  **THE 4<sup>TH</sup> COMMANDMENT**

7  **Q. WHAT IS "HOLY"?**

Hebrew: qadosh Set apart, dedicated to sacred purposes; holy sacred, clean, morally or ceremonially pure. The verb *qadash* means "to set apart something or someone for holy purposes."

Greek: hagios Sacred pure blameless, consecrated, separated, properly revered. Set apart for God, reserved for God and His service

8  **THE LORD "RESTED"**

- Did God go to sleep for 24 hours?
- Did God "Do Nothing" for 24 hours?
- Q. What did He do?
- A. He stopped doing what He had been doing.
- He rested from His usual work of creating.
- And He set aside one day for us to do the same.
- He never intended it to be religious service!

9  **DO NO USUAL WORK**

- Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day is a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation. You shall do no work on it; it is the Sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings. Leviticus 23:3 NKJV
- "Tell the people of Isra'el, 'In the seventh month, the first of the month is to be for you a day of complete rest for remembering, a holy convocation announced with blasts on the *shofar*. 25Do not do any kind of ordinary work, and bring an offering

made by fire to *ADONAI*." Leviticus 23:24-25 CJB

- THINK: "No occupational work"

#### 10 **GENERAL OBSERVATIONS**

- There are no prescribed formulas written in the Bible. They were created by the Rabbi.
- Sabbath was always done in the home, up until 325 A.D. when Constantine mandated it be in the "church" building and made gathering in the home illegal.
- Sabbath starts at sunset Friday night and concludes on Saturday at sunset.
- It is a family gathering in the home: Ekklesia.
- God made sabbath for us, to enjoy a day off from our usual work, and spend time with our family and with Him.

#### 11 **SUGGESTIONS FOR OBSERVING THE SABBATH**

- Start at dusk on Friday night.
- Have a time of Prayer and thanksgiving.
- Bread & Wine (Juice)
- Play some worship music and spend time worshipping the Lord.
- Take Saturday off from all your usual (occupational) work.
- Spend time with Him. (what works for you?)
- Spend time relaxing with your spouse and family.

#### 12 **COLOSSIANS 2:16-19 NKJV**

- So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, 17which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ. 18Let no one cheat you of your reward, taking delight in *false* humility and worship of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, 19and not holding fast to the Head, from whom all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase *that is* from God.
